

CyberNI Week Overview

CyberNI Week 2026 will use the theme 'Collaborating to Strengthen Cyber Resilience' and brings together Public Sector, Industry, Academia, Charity & Voluntary and Citizens across Northern Ireland. Supporting the objectives of the National Cyber Strategy 2022, CyberNI Week aims to foster collaboration and share best practices to enhance cyber resilience across the sectors.

CyberNI Week will highlight the importance of unified efforts in addressing the ever evolving cyber threat landscape, ensure that the sectors in Northern Ireland have robust defence mechanisms in place to combat cyber threats, and help build a secure digital future.

Key Objectives

- 1. **Promote Cross-Sector Collaboration:** Facilitate dialogue and partnerships across the different sectors within Northern Ireland, including Public Sector, Industry, Academia, Charity & Voluntary and Citizens, to create a unified approach to cyber security.
- 2. **Share Cyber Security Best Practices:** Provide a platform for sharing strategies, tools and techniques that enhance cyber resilience across different sectors.
- 3. Enhance Awareness and Education: Increase the understanding of current cyber threats, vulnerabilities and the importance of protective/preventive measures to mitigate cyber risks.
- 4. **Encourage Innovation:** Showcase new technologies and innovative solutions that can strengthen cyber defences.
- 5. **Community and Network building:** Build a community within Northern Ireland that are working towards improving cyber resilience and sharing cyber security best practices.
- 6. **Cyber Growth:** Increase in the number of people in Northern Ireland who have the skills they need to enter the cyber workforce.
